RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Board Chair to sign an Agreement with Calaveras County Office of Education for the provision of a Friday Night Live Mentoring Program in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

As part of the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) Block Grant, the Calaveras Health and Human Services Agency – Behavioral Health Services Substance Abuse Program (SAP) has Primary Prevention Set-Aside funds to support youth health promotion and substance abuse prevention in Calaveras County.

The purpose of the Friday Night Live (FNL) Mentoring Program is to support youth using the FNL Mentoring model by selecting FNL Mentoring advisors at selected high schools and middle schools to create opportunities for youth to work on substance abuse prevention issues in their respective schools.

The overarching program goal reflects the goal of the Calaveras County Prevention Plan, which is to reduce underage drinking and dangerous drinking (binge drinking). Additional goals include engaging youth in developing alternatives to recreational substance abuse, and increasing youth connections to their school and community.

FINANCING:

There is no impact to the County General Fund.

The maximum amount payable under this Agreement during the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 is sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000). Costs are paid utilizing federal Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) Block Grant funds. Appropriate revenue and expenditures are included in the Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board may choose to do any of the following:
