**RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a Proclamation Recognizing National Voter Registration Day on September 22, 2020.

**DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:**

Organizations across the Nation will be participating in a coordinated effort to encourage eligible citizens to register to vote on National Voter Registration Day, September 22, 2020. This single day of coordinated field, technology, and media efforts was intended to create awareness of voter registration opportunities.

Voters may:

- Register online at <http://registertovote.ca.gov/>
- Request the Elections Office mail a voter registration card to their home
- Register to vote at your local Post Office or the DMV

The registration deadline for the November 3, 2020 General Election is October 19, 2020. Any voter who registers after this date must come into the County Registrar of Voters office or any Vote Center in the County to pick up their ballot.

With the COVID-19 pandemic looming over the November General Election, we want to assure voters that we will uphold election traditions and make sure that every citizen wishing to do so can cast their vote safely, whether they choose to vote by mail or in person at a Vote Center.

The safety of our voters and poll workers is of paramount concern, which is why all Vote Centers will be set up in accordance with social distancing guidelines and sanitation of voting equipment will be performed between every voter. Personal Protective equipment will be provided and required by all.

**FINANCING:**

There is no financial impact to the General Fund associated with this proclamation.


