**RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize the Board Chair to sign the Willow Glen Care Center Agreement for residential mental health rehabilitation services for adults with serious mental illness in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, to be utilized on an as needed basis.

**DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:**

The Health and Human Services Agency- Behavioral Health Services – Mental Health Program (MHP) has the responsibility of providing mental health services to adults with serious mental illnesses that sometimes results in a need for placement in a residential treatment facility. Willow Glen Care Center is a long term residential care facility that offers specialized mental health services. Services include board and care, medication management, support services, and rehabilitation services. MHP utilizes residential treatment facilities for conservatees under the Lanterman-Petris-Short Act who require specialized residential treatment services. Services under this Agreement are to be utilized on an as needed basis.

**FINANCING:**

The maximum amount payable under this Agreement shall not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. Appropriate expenditures have been included in the FY 2020-21 MHP budget (10620010-5528). Services provided under this Agreement will be paid for utilizing Local Mental Health Realignment funds.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board of Supervisors (Board) may choose to do any of the following:

1. Uphold the recommendation to approve the Agreement; or
2. Continue the item to another date for further consideration. This option is not recommended unless the Board specifically requests additional information which

cannot be obtained during this meeting; or


3. Deny the request. This is not recommended because the services are required to be provided.
