RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Board Chair to sign an Agreement with Mental Health Management I, Inc. doing business as Canyon Manor in an amount not to exceed \$544,795 for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, to be utilized on an as needed basis.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

The Health and Human Services Agency – Behavioral Health Division - Mental Health Program (MHP) is required under the Lanterman-Petris-Short Act to provide services to County residents in need of intensive support and rehabilitation services.

Mental Health Management I, Inc. Doing Business As Canyon Manor (Canyon Manor) is licensed as a Mental Health Rehabilitation Center (MHRC) by the State of California that provides twenty-four (24) hour intensive support and rehabilitation services. This facility is designed to assist clients, 18 years or older, with mental disorders in the development of skills to become self-sufficient and capable of increasing levels of independent functioning as they potentially decrease the level of care required. Canyon Manor provides eligible County residents with access to designated mental health services, including intensive support and rehabilitation services.

This amount is based on current usage and to ensure the ongoing availability of treatment services. This amount includes meeting the anticipated need for both existing and future clients, as current clients being served step down their level of care. These services are utilized on an as-needed basis only, as determined by the Director of the Health and Human Services Agency, or designee.

FINANCING:

The maximum amount payable is five hundred forty-four thousand seven hundred ninety-five dollars (\$544,795) for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. Expenditures under this Agreement are paid utilizing 1991 Mental Health Realignment and offset by a portion of the

consumer's monthly Social Security income. Appropriate expenditures are budgeted for Fiscal Year 2020-21 MHP budget (Org. Key 10620010 Object Code 5538.)

ALTERNATIVES:


The Board of supervisors (Board) may choose to do any of the following:


- a) Uphold the recommendation to approve the renewal of the agreement; or
