**RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a Proclamation recognizing the continued efforts of Calaveras Recovers.

**DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:**

The Butte Fire was the worst catastrophic and traumatic events in the recent memory of Calaveras County. Calaveras Recovers has been and continues to be an incredible force in and for the County since its inception October 18, 2015. This group is made up of Volunteers who have jobs, families and lives of their own that they have taken time away from to help those from the County who suffered insurmountable losses.

Calaveras Recovers, with the help of many faith based groups from all over the United States have helped 220 survivors with both immediate and long term needs, provided complete household contents for 26 households under the "House in a Box" program and constructed 7 homes, with 3 additional homes near completion for those survivors who lost their homes and were uninsured or under insured.

Without the assistance of Calaveras Recovers and the many volunteer organizations working with them, recovery from the Butte Fire Incident would not have been achievable.

Calaveras Recovers efforts continue both at the community and County level two years after the incident and have committed to stay intact so that the structure of the group is in place if called upon by the community
