**RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the Acceptance of Allotment and all documents related to the acceptance and claiming of the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Tuberculosis Prevention and Control funding in the amount of \$3,937 for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

**DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:**

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Tuberculosis Control Branch (TBCB) released a real-time allotment that provides the Calaveras Health and Human Services Agency – Public Health Division (PHD) an allocation of \$3,937 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18, so that PHD staff can work with TBCB staff to carry out Tuberculosis (TB) control efforts. CDPH issues three allotments per Fiscal Year, this is the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final for fiscal year 2017-18. This allotment is comprised of \$1,834 state and \$2,103 federal funds.

This funding can be used to purchase equipment (video, cellphone, etc.) to facilitate Direct Observed Therapy if needed; Anti-Tuberculosis medications for individuals without health insurance; training for personnel working within the program; and Tuberculosis training and educational materials.

**FINANCING:**

There is no impact to the County General Fund.

The total amount of the allotment is \$3,937 which is comprised of \$1,834 state and \$2,103 federal funds.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board could choose not to approve the receipt of these funds. This is not recommended as the County would lose out on the opportunity to draw down State and Federal funding for Tuberculosis prevention and control efforts.
