RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Board Chair to sign annual Point Source Emissions Data Grant agreements, and the Air Pollution Control Officer to sign associated grant amendments and requests for payment. Requires a 4/5s vote of the Board.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

California Air Resources Board (CARB) has approved the Calaveras County Air Pollution Control District (District) for a grant under Assembly Bill (AB) 197. The grant award of (not to exceed) \$8,583 is for related expenses necessary to assist the Calaveras County Air Pollution Control District with reporting of emissions inventory data for use in the Integrated Emissions Visualization Tool.

Assembly Bill (AB) 197 directs CARB to make available on its website, and update at least annually, the emissions of greenhouse gases (GHG), criteria pollutants, and toxic air contaminants for each facility that reports to CARB and the various air districts in California.

Implementation of this provision requires a considerable level of additional effort on the part of the air districts to compile, review and quality assure the criteria and toxic air pollutant emissions data reported by facilities in their jurisdiction.

While requirements exist for annual reporting of GHG and criteria pollutants, the Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Act (AB 2588, 1987) requires facilities and local air districts to report toxic emissions only once every four years. CARB is providing grant funds to assist local air districts in the annual compilation and review of criteria and toxics air pollutant emissions data to support the requirements of AB 197.

FINANCING:


Point Source Emissions Data Grant

ALTERNATIVES:


The Board could opt to reject the grant, resulting in the District performing activities required under AB 197 without state fiscal support.


