DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:



The California State Parks Division of Boating and Waters requires language pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code, Section 663.7 (e) be included in the current and future resolutions. The language is as follows:



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County is authorized to participate in the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid Program, that it shall expend on boating safety programs not less than an amount equal to 100% of the amount received by the County from personal property taxes on vessels, and that the County Auditor is authorized to certify the amount of prior year vessel taxes received by the County.

RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT AN AWARD FROM THE CALIFORNIA PARKS AND RECREATION DIVISION OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS BOATING SAFETY AND ENFORCEMENT AID FOR REVENUES IN SUPPORT OF THE CALAVERAS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE BOATING SAFETY UNIT FOR FY 2019-20 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$174,926.

WHEREAS, the Calaveras County Sheriff's Office submitted an application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW) for Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid, and;

WHEREAS, the Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid Program will fund the operations of the Calaveras County Sheriff's Office Boating Safety Unit, and;

WHEREAS, the Calaveras County Sheriff's Office operates a Boating Safety Unit. The responsibility of this Unit is to provide law enforcement and rescue services to each of the County's fresh water lakes and reservoirs, and;

WHEREAS, the DBW program subvention for FY 2019-20 is \$174,926. These revenues will be budgeted in the FY 2019-20 Sheriff's Office Marine Safety Budget (10100360) to offset County General Fund costs accordingly, and;

WHEREAS, that the Sheriff, Captain, or Lieutenant with the Calaveras County Sheriff's Office are hereby designated and duly authorized to deposit the funding allocation and execute the purchase pursuant to the County's Purchasing Policy and grant documents associated with the California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways Boating Safety Enforcement Aid Program, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors approves the award for the FY 2019-20 Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid Program in the amount of \$174,926.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County is authorized to participate in the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Boating Safety and Enforcement Financial Aid Program, that it shall expend on

boating safety programs not less than an amount equal to 100% of the amount received by the County from personal property taxes on vessels, and that the County Auditor is authorized to certify the amount of prior year vessel taxes received by the County.
