**RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize the Board Chair to sign an Agreement with JDT Consultants, Inc. for the provision of therapeutic behavioral services for a not to exceed amount of \$400,000 for the period July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2021.

**DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:**

The Health and Human Services Agency – Behavioral Health Services Mental Health Division (MHD) is required to provide, as-needed, intensive Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS), when the treatment plan necessitates, to Medi-Cal insured children and youth under age 21 with severe mental or emotional disorders. These services are provided in the home, community, or placement setting. This agreement with JDT Consultants, Inc. (JDT) is to provide the aforementioned services.

**FINANCING:**

There is no impact to the General Fund.

The maximum amount payable under this Agreement is four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021. Expenditures under this Agreement are offset by funds from Medi-Cal, state general funds, and local mental health realignment. Appropriate expenditures are included in the Fiscal Year 2019-20 MHD budget 10620010-5538.

**ALTERNATIVES:**


The Board may choose to do any of the following:
