RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the 2019 Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Agreement with Kautz Vineyards, Inc., doing business as Ironstone Vineyards and Winery, for the Term from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022, and authorize the Board Chair to execute the Agreement.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

Kautz Vineyards, Inc., doing business as Ironstone Vineyards and Winery (Ironstone), requires supplemental law enforcement services from July 1st, 2019 to June 30th, 2022 for its special events at its place of business. Supplemental law enforcement services are being provided at Ironstone Vineyards and Winery to mitigate public safety risks correlated with its concerts and other special events.

Execution of this contract will not reduce the normal and regular on going service that the Calaveras County Sheriff’s Office currently provides to the public. Contract revenues are in place to directly offset overtime expenditures incurred in the execution of the Agreement with Ironstone. During the summer months included in the Agreement Term, Ironstone will schedule multiple concerts and one (1) fireworks event per summer for which supplemental law enforcement services will be provided by the Sheriff’s Office.

This Board Action request the Board to approve the 2019 Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Agreement with Kautz Vineyards, Inc., doing business as Ironstone Vineyards and Winery, for the Term from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022, and authorize the Board Chair to exercise the Agreement.

FINANCING:

Revenue will be recorded to the Sheriff Office’s Patrol budget unit 10100320 (General Fund) where overtime expenditures are incurred.


ALTERNATIVES:


The Board of Supervisors could disallow the provision of supplemental law enforcement services to Ironstone. This option is not recommended by Staff as a lack of law enforcement presence at Ironstone’s special events could jeopardize public safety. If the County were to
