RECOMMENDATION:

1) Adopt the plans and specifications for construction of the West Point Bikeway Project; 2) Grant the Director of Public Works the authority to incorporate any final changes into the bid documents before advertising for bids; and 3) Authorize the Department of Public Works to solicit formal construction bids.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

Bicycling is an active mode of transportation that provides both personal health and environmental benefits. The town of West Point is a bicycle friendly community that currently has minimal facilities for the residents to utilize. The proposed West Point Bikeway project will enhance safety and promote bicycling in the community with the installation of Class III bike routes. Class III bike routes provide for shared lane use for bicyclists and motor vehicles, and will be installed along the following two roadway segments in West Point:

1. Main Street between West Point Pioneer Road (Highway 26) to the north and Highway 26 to the south; and
2. Pine Street between Main Street and Highway 26.

These bike routes will allow for safer and convenient bicycling to key community destinations including West Point Elementary School, the Library, and the post office.

Share the road signage and pavement markings will be installed along both sides of the roadway segments, in addition to resurfacing and restriping the roadway. These improvements are considered a minor alteration to an existing public facility. As such, the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and a Notice of Exemption was filed with the County Clerk on March 13, 2019. All work will occur within the existing right of way. Public Works has completed the plans (Exhibit A) and specifications (Exhibit B) for this work.

As required by Public Contract Code §2039, the Board shall adopt plans and specifications for all public projects. Once plans and specifications are adopted by the Board of Supervisors the Project will move to the construction phase with the advertisement of the construction contract documents. Construction is anticipated to be completed in fall 2019.

FINANCING:

There is no impact to the County General Fund.

The construction phase of the project will be funded by Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funds obtained through the Calaveras Council of Governments and the Road Fund.


Necessary budget appropriations are included in the fiscal year 2019-20 Department of Public Works Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget (12000010-9032).

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board may choose to do any of the following:

1. Support the Department's recommendation;
2. Continue the item to another date for further consideration. This action is not recommended unless the Board specifically requests additional information which cannot be obtained during this meeting; or,
3. Deny the request. This is not recommended, as project completion and any federal funds that have been authorized would be put at risk.


