RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution ordering a Special Election on November 5, 2019, allowing the City of Angels to submit two measures to the voters for approval.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY: The City of Angels has requested in their Resolution Nos. 19-24 and 19-26 to call a Special Election to place two measures on the ballot for voter approval.

The two ballot measures shall read and appear on the ballot as follows:

Measure C

Shall the measure permanently increasing the City of Angels' transient occupancy tax from ten percent (10%) to twelve percent (12%), to generate an additional \$200,000 annually from hotel and vacation rental guests, to fund essential public services including emergency fire response and protection, police patrols, public works maintenance, business attraction and retention; and to increase the City's appropriations limit for Fiscal Years 2020-2024 by the amount of tax proceeds received by the increase, be approved?

A RESOLUTION ORDERING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2019 ALLOWING THE CITY OF ANGELS CAMP TO SUBMIT TWO MEASURES TO THE VOTERS

WHEREAS, the City of Angels in their Resolution Nos. 19-24 and 19-26 have requested that the Board of Supervisors order a Special Election to be held on November 5, 2019. The ballot measures shall read and appear on the ballot as follows:

Measure C

Shall the measure permanently increasing the City of Angels' transient occupancy tax from ten percent (10%) to twelve percent (12%), to generate an additional \$200,000 annually from hotel and vacation rental guests, to fund essential public services including emergency fire response and protection, police patrols, public works maintenance, business attraction and retention; and to increase the City's appropriations limit for Fiscal Years 2020-2024 by the amount of tax proceeds received by the increase, be approved?

WHEREAS, section 10002 of the Elections Code of State of California, authorizes the Board of Supervisors to permit the County Elections Official to render specified services; and

WHEREAS, the County Election Official has determined that no unusual problems would arise from calling said election.

WHEREAS, The impartial analysis by County Counsel in the form required by subparagraph (b) of Elections Code section 9160 shall be prepared on or before August 8, 2019, and filed with the Elections Official no later than 5:00 p.m. on said day and included in the official ballot materials.

WHEREAS, notice be, and it hereby is, given that the final date for submission to the Elections Official of arguments not to exceed 300 words in length for or against the measures shall be July 29, 2019, and such arguments shall be submitted to the Elections Official, 891 Mountain Ranch Road, San Andreas, CA 95249, no later than 5:00 p.m. on said day and included in the official ballot materials.

WHEREAS, the final date for submission to the Elections Official of rebuttal arguments for or against the measures, to the extent rebuttal arguments are permitted by section 9167 of

the Elections Code, shall be August 8, 2019, and such arguments shall be submitted to the Elections Official, 891 Mountain Ranch Road, San Andreas, CA 95249, no later than 5:00 p.m. on said day and included in the official ballot materials.

WHEREAS, a fiscal impact statement by the County Auditor, which is authorized by Elections Code section 9160(c), is not required.

WHEREAS, the Clerk conducting the election may publish a notice of the election in a newspaper of general circulation within the County of Calaveras not later than fifty (50) days prior to the election.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a Special Election is hereby ordered for the City of Angels measures, to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Elections Department has the authority to render specified services to the City of Angels for the purpose of conducting the City's election, pursuant to Election Code sections 1301(a), 1405(b) & 9222.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the City shall reimburse the County of Calaveras upon billing for all services performed in order to conduct their election.
