RECOMMENDATION:

1) Dispense with competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Chapter 3.28 of the County Ordinance; 2) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to piggyback on Sourcwell contract #081716-NAF and issue a purchase order to National Auto Fleet Group of Watsonville, CA for the acquisition of two (2) 2020 Mack Granite 42FR Chassis with 10' Dump Body in an amount not to exceed \$305,385, plus any applicable taxes and document fees and one (1) 2020 Mack Granite 64FR Chassis with 15' Dump Body in an amount not to exceed \$187,325, plus any applicable taxes and document fees; and 3) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to utilize this awarded contract for any future subsequent purchases through any extended term, so long as funding is available within the requesting department's budget.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

At the May 28, 2019 Board of Supervisors meeting, the Department of Public Works requested approval to purchase Butte Fire road recovery equipment, including the three (3) Mack Granite Dump Trucks. While the Board approved the purchase as presented, Public Works has had difficulty extracting the necessary information and documentation from the vendor. The purchase price and specifications remain unchanged, only the vendor is being replaced.

The Board is being asked to authorize the Purchasing Agent to piggyback on Sourcwell competitively bid contract #081719-NAF with National Auto Fleet Group, for the purchase of two (2) 10' dump trucks and issue a purchase order in an amount not to exceed \$305,385 and one (1) 15' dump truck and issue a purchase order in an amount not to exceed \$187,325, and authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue additional purchases through any extended term of the current contract so long as funding is available within the requesting department's budget. The County of Calaveras has been a participating member of Sourcwell since February 2008.

Piggybacking on another public agency's competitively bid contract, or that of a cooperative public purchasing alliance such as Sourcwell, offers a small government agency like Calaveras the benefits of leveraging deep discounts through volume purchases achieved by larger agencies. It also allows us to utilize competitively sourced contracts that would otherwise have to be competitively bid in-house with no resources available to do so.



Funds for the purchase are available in the FY 2019-20 Department of Public Works – Roads and Bridges Division budget (10200760-5701). Funds totaling \$1,225,000 have been transferred from the Public Works – Butte Fire Road Recovery budget (10100971-5701) to the Roads and Bridges Division for the purchase of the Butte Fire road recovery equipment.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board could choose not to approve the department's request. This action is not recommended since this would prevent the department's ability to effectively and efficiently perform road maintenance and repairs.


