RECOMMENDATION:

1) Adopt design plans and specifications for construction of the 2017 Winter Storms Hawver Road Project, FEMA PA-09-CA-4308-PW-00473; 2) Authorize the Director of Public Works to make minor edits to plans and specs; and 3) Authorize the Department of Public Works to solicit formal construction bids.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

During the winter of 2017, Calaveras County experienced historic rain and flooding resulting in high velocity flood waters that exceeded the capacity of the local drainage system at three sites on Hawver Road. This included: 1) damage to a low water crossing encompassing six, 48" diameter pipe culverts; 2) severe erosion to roadway ditches and damage to two, 18" diameter pipe culverts; and 3) damage to gabion basket headwalls/wing walls at a 36" diameter cross culvert.

The Hawver Road Project will consist of addressing the concerns listed above and returning the facility to its pre-disaster condition. All construction activity will occur within the County's existing right-of-way.

Environmental clearances for the work have been obtained. Requests have been submitted for all necessary permits from resource agencies. These applications are being tracked and are on target for issuance in July 2019. Once permits are issued, the project will be ready to proceed to the construction bid phase.

The County's engineering consultant, Holdrege and Kull Consulting Engineers and Geologists, has prepared project design plans specifications, attached hereto. As required by Public Contract Code §22039, the Board of Supervisors shall adopt plans, specifications, and working details for all public projects. As permit agencies may require specific measures to be implemented, we request that the Board give the authority to the Director of Public Works to make minor adjustments to these plans as necessary or required by permits.

Once the plans and specifications are adopted by the Board of Supervisors, the project will move to the construction phase with the advertisement of the construction bid documents. Construction is anticipated to be completed in 2019.

FINANCING:

Funding for this project is budgeted in the Office of Emergency Management's 2017 Winter Storm Events budget unit (10100940-5701). The Department of Public Works staff shall coordinate fiscal oversight and project administration.
