RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the Contract with Dirty Werks for abatement services in the amount not to exceed \$150,000 for a term of two years from date of approval.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

Cannabis eradication requires a unique and particular skillset. Dirty Werks has proven to the County that their company possesses the skillset and equipment required, and are willing to accept the risks that may be involved. Dirty Werks also provides abatement services for non-cannabis cases.

The County has discretion under Chapter 3.28 of the County Code to seek services without formal bidding when there is an immediate need and the method of selection best serves the County's interest in economy and efficiency as in this case. It should be noted that an RFP has been issued to allow other interested and qualified contractors to compete for future contracts of this nature.

FINANCING:

Abatement and administrative costs are initially funded through Nuisance Abatement. These costs are then recovered by placing a lien on the property which may be collected by placing it on the tax roll.

ALTERNATIVES:


The amount of the contracts could be reduced however staff does not recommend this.
