**RECOMMENDATION:**

**DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:**

On September 12, 2017, the Board of Supervisors (Board) awarded the Tree Mortality Project Manager Program to TSS Consultants. As part of the Implementation Plan that survey of dead and dying trees, issuance and gathering of ROE's and performing public outreach, TSS committed to updating the Board of Supervisors. TSS is therefore providing the Tree Mortality Program Implementation Update.

**FINANCING:**

TSS is being paid through the tree mortality program (10101000-5271). Since this is a California Disaster Assistance Act (CDAA) related program, the County can anticipate up to 75% program cost reimbursement.

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
