AN ORDINANCE
ADDING SECTION 2.24.040 TO THE CALAVERAS COUNTY CODE
ESTABLISHING REDUCED TIME PERIODS FOR
ISSUANCE OF DUPLICATE WARRANTS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras, hereby finds, declares, and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The following Section is added to Chapter 2.24 of the Calaveras County Code to read:

Section 2.24.040 — Establishment of reduced time periods allowed by statute

- A. **DUPLICATE WARRANTS:** When a legal owner or custodian files an affidavit of lost check with the Auditor-Controller, the Auditor shall issue a duplicate warrant no sooner than 7 (seven) days after the mailing of the original warrant as allowed under the provisions of Title 3, Division 3, Chapter 5, Article 3 of the California State Government Code.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY

If any section or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, unlawful or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed and adopted this Ordinance and each and all provisions thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more of said provisions be declared unconstitutional, unlawful or otherwise invalid.

SECTION 3. CEQA

The Board of Supervisors hereby finds that this Ordinance is exempt and therefore not subject to review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15060(c)(2)(the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment) and 15061(b)(3)(there is no possibility the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment).

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days from the date of its passage. The text of this Ordinance, or a summary thereof, including the names of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance shall be published within fifteen (15) days after the date hereof in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Calaveras, State of California.
