Resolution No. 19-26**

**A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A BALLOT MEASURE CHANGING THE
OFFICES OF CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER FROM ELECTED
POSITIONS TO APPOINTED POSITIONS AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO
BE HELD NOVEMBER 5, 2019**

WHEREAS, the California Government Code Section 36501 requires general law cities such as the City of Angels to maintain the positions of City Clerk and City Treasurer; and

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Angles desires that the positions of City Clerk and City Treasurer be changed from elected positions to appointed positions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 36508, the City may submit to the voters the questions of whether the positions of City Clerk and City Treasurer shall be elected or appointed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 36510, if the majority of the votes cast on the proposition regarding the City Clerk and City Treasurer is for converting the position to appointive positions, the City Council shall appoint such officers upon the expiration of the term of the current City Clerk and City Treasurer in November 2022; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Angels to call a City Ballot Measure on November 5, 2019, and consolidate such City Ballot Measure Election with the Special Election to be held on November 5, 2019; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Angels City Council hereby resolves and orders as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to the requirements of Section 10418 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras to consent and agree to the consolidation of a City Ballot Measure election with the Special Election on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 for the purpose of the ballot question:

Shall the offices of City Clerk and City Treasurer be appointive?	Yes

Section 2. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10002 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras to permit the County Election Department to conduct the General Municipal Election.

Section 3. That the County Election department is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and one form of ballot shall be used.

Section 4. Pursuant to Elections Code section 10002, the City Council requests that the Calaveras County Board of Supervisors authorize the Calaveras County Registrar of Voters to provide any and all services necessary to conducting the election on November 5, 2019. The City agrees to pay for such services.

Section 5. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the County election Department.

Section 6. The City Clerk is directed, pursuant to Elections Code section 9280, to transmit a copy of the measure to the City Attorney for the purpose of preparing an impartial analysis of the measure, to be submitted no later than the final date for such analysis as established by the Calaveras County Elections Official.

Section 7. The ballot measure question as set forth above is the full text of the measure.

Section 8. The City Council authorizes the Mayor, or in his or her absence the Mayor Pro Tern, on behalf of the City Council, to file the written primary argument in support of the ballot measure described above pursuant to Article 4 of Chapter 3 of Division 9 of the California Elections Code. Signatories to the argument shall be determined by the Mayor and may include the Mayor signing on behalf of the City Council. Arguments for or against the measure shall be no longer than 300 words in length.

Section 9. The City Clerk has fixed 5:00 p.m. on the last date established by the County Elections Official for receipt of arguments for or against the measure.

Section 10. This resolution supersedes Resolution 19-14 previously adopted by the City Council.






