The Calaveras County Fish and Game Commission's purpose is to develop facts, make findings and forward recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on matters concerning organization, promotion and supervision of community and county-wide fish and game programs and activities within the county. To advise on the propagation, preservation and conservation of fish and game in the county.

Members are required to annually file Statement of Economic Interest - Form 700.

Meetings are held at 5:30 PM on the fourth Wednesday of the month (January through October) in the Board Chambers at the Government Center in San Andreas, and hereby submits the following report for consideration, and recommends approval by, the Calaveras County Board of Supervisors acting as the Governing Body. The Commission made the following change in the Bi-laws to help meet Quorum: Four members must be present to quorum.

Accomplishments: The Commission held the annual **Kids fishing Day** on May 4, 2019, at Murphys creek.
